BOOK WEEK IN ROOM 11



In week 5 the year 2's celebrated book week by engaging in a range of book related activities. We visited the dark room to engage with the whole school stimulus and conducted our BIG TALK ready for our BIG WRITE on the Thursday. We used our senses to describe what we saw, heard, and felt in this space. We also used this space as a means of connecting to country. We took part in some dreaming meditation and learnt the Kurna names for a range of Australian animals. Some of the students even used this language in their BIG WRITES!

We read the wordless picture book 'The Boy and the Elephant.' Before reading we made some predictions using our prior knowledge and the pictures on the front cover. We then thought of two questions that we had about the book. After reading the book we used our VCOP skills to write an engaging opener for the first page of the book. We discussed lots of different openers such as sound and use of dialogue. Students wrote 3 descriptive sentences for the first page using interesting punctuation, connectives and WOW words.
